## **Sunlit Gold**



# Glossary

## **AI (Adobe Illustrator)**

A vector-based file format used for creating scalable graphics. Ideal for logos and designs that need to maintain quality at any size. Requires Adobe Illustrator or compatible software to edit.

## **EPS (Encapsulated PostScript)**

A versatile file format often used for high-quality vector graphics. EPS files are suitable for large-scale printing and professional design applications.

## **JPEG (Joint Photographic Experts Group)**

A commonly used file format for images. Best for photos and web use but not ideal for graphics that require transparency or scalability.

## **PNG (Portable Network Graphics)**

A file format suitable for web use, offering support for transparency. Commonly used for online graphics, including logos, with a clean background.

## **PDF (Portable Document Format)**

A file format designed for sharing and viewing documents consistently across devices. Used for proofs, guidelines, and print-ready materials.

## **SVG (Scalable Vector Graphics)**

A web-friendly vector file format that allows for scalability without quality loss. Often used for digital logos and responsive designs.

## **CMYK**

The color model used for printing, consisting of cyan, magenta, yellow, and black. Files intended for print should use CMYK colors.

## **RGB**

The color model used for digital screens, consisting of red, green, and blue. Files intended for web, app, or screen use should use RGB colors.

## **Favicon**

A small icon associated with a website or brand, typically displayed in browser tabs, bookmarks, and app icons.

## **Vector Graphics**

Graphics based on mathematical equations, allowing them to be scaled infinitely without losing quality. File formats like AI, EPS, and SVG are vector-based.

## **Raster Graphics**

Graphics made up of pixels, resulting in quality loss when scaled beyond their resolution. File formats like JPEG and PNG are raster-based.



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
